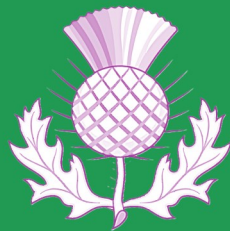

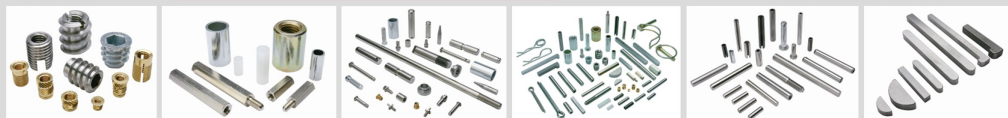

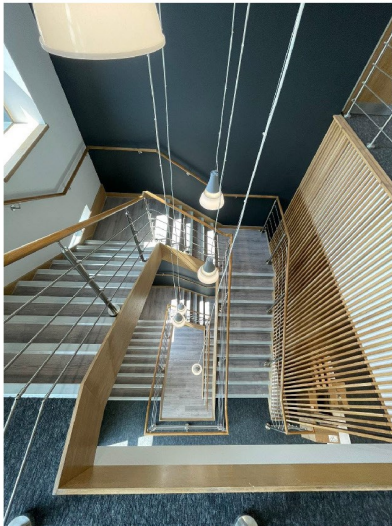

## Walter MacGregor

**10.09.1947 – 27.11.2024**

The pipe band world lost one of its characters when Walter MacGregor passed away in November last year.

He was a hugely influential figure in the London and South of England Branch which he joined in 2009 as the Treasurer, going on to fill key posts of Chairman, Branch President and National Director and Trustee.

He was a great organiser, and for many years worked with the team at Corby to ensure the Highland Gathering was well supported by the RSPBA (Royal Scottish Pipe Band Association).

Somewhat surprisingly for a bass drummer, he was passionate about solo piping and the entries in the solo contests have grown steadily over recent years.

None of this does justice to Walter's huge character. He was very hospitable, very generous and very entertaining company. He had a phenomenal memory for tunes and their names, he knew so many of the band personnel by name, and he worked tirelessly for the good of the pipe band world. We will find substitutes to run the accounts, sell raffle tickets, plan contests and man the microphone, but big Walter was unique and quite irreplaceable.

As a tribute to his memory, the Massed Bands will play Walter MacGregor's March, written for him many years ago by Pipe Major Jim McCombie.
